



# The Governor's Climate "Agenda"

[ZERO – basic to rest]:

**Create the New Oregon Climate Authority**

- Align state programs and expertise to achieve the state's climate policy goals
- Expertise must include understanding *Best Available Science* and knowing when that requires new climate targets.



# The Governor's Climate "Agenda"

## ONE: **Decarbonize** – Implement a Market-Based Program to Reduce Emissions ["Cap and Trade" = CEJ]

- Achieve our state climate emissions reduction goals,
- while protecting our manufacturing sector and
- mitigating impacts on
  - low-income and
  - rural communities,
  - communities of color, and Tribes



## The Governor's Climate "Agenda"

### **TWO: Decarbonize – Add 50,000 Electric Vehicles to Oregon Roads by 2020**

- Expand electric vehicle infrastructure and incentives to support 50,000 electric vehicles on Oregon roads by 2020

### **THREE: Decarbonize the Electricity System**

- Achieve the state's renewable energy targets
- and encourage grid modernization
- while maintaining affordable and competitive electricity rates



## The Governor's Climate "Agenda"

### **FOUR: Decarbonize – Expand Access to Clean Energy Services**

Expand opportunities for residential, municipal, and commercial customers to access clean energy services from their utilities [and from PCEF and from OET and from CEJ and from new building codes]

### **FIVE: Decarbonize – Strengthen Energy Efficiency Investments**

Maintain and strengthen energy efficiency investments in residential, commercial, industrial and agricultural sectors, expand the reach of energy efficiency programs to ensure all communities benefit [and from PCEF and from OET and from CEJ and from new building codes]

### **SIX: Increase Industrial Energy Savings and Competitiveness**

Support world-leading industrial efficiency initiatives by Oregon’s large industrial utility customers

### **SEVEN: Invest in Climate Solutions That Foster Resilience**

Pursue climate solutions that benefit rural communities and Tribes, support working lands, and foster resilience to climate change
